

## **Mental Measurements Yearbook**

**Access:** Mental Measurements Yearbook (MMY) is available from all networked computers on campus and is SFX enabled.

**Scope:** Mental Measurements Yearbook, from the Buros Institute of Mental Measurements, contains the most recent descriptive information and critical reviews of new and revised tests from the Buros Institute's 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Yearbooks. The database covers more than 2,000 commercially-available educational, personality, aptitude, neuropsychological, achievement and intelligence tests.

Each entry includes test name and classification; author(s); publisher, publication date; price; time requirements; score descriptions; levels; and intended populations. The online Yearbook is updated every six months to ensure timely access to new test information and to eliminate out-dated descriptions and reviews when new ones are available. A valuable resource for academic and professional libraries, the Yearbook provides a convenient tool for educators, counselors, psychologists, personnel directors, lawyers, and medical professionals to locate and evaluate testing instruments. Subjects include: Psychology; Analysis; Counseling; Personality Tests; Psychosocial Studies, and Educational Testing.

**Dates of Coverage:** Coverage is from 1985 to the present.
