

SOCIAL SCIENCES CITATION INDEX

The *Social Sciences Citation Index* is a multidisciplinary index to the journal literature of the social sciences. It fully indexes more than 1,725 journals across 50 social sciences disciplines, and it indexes individually selected, relevant items from over 3,300 of the world's leading scientific and technical journals.

In addition, the *Social Sciences Citation Index*:

- Provides access to current information and retrospective data from 1956 forward.
Note that you may not have access to all data years.
- Averages 2,900 new records per week.
- Includes approximately 60,000 new cited references per week.
- As of January 1992, contains searchable, full-length, English-language author abstracts for approximately 60% of the articles in the index.
