

SCIENCE CITATION INDEX

The Science Citation Index Expanded is a multidisciplinary index to the journal literature of the sciences. It fully indexes 5,900 major journals across 150 scientific disciplines—that's 2,100 more journals than the print and CD-ROM versions of the SCI. The Science Citation Index Expanded includes all cited references captured from indexed articles.

In addition, the Science Citation Index Expanded:

Provides access to current information and retrospective data from 1945 forward. Note that you may not have access to all data years.

Averages 19,000 new records per week.

Includes approximately 423,000 new cited references per week.

As of January 1991, contains searchable, full-length, English-language author abstracts for approximately 70% of the articles in the index.
