Princeton University Ph.D. Dissertations

The archival, non-circulating copy of a dissertation may be consulted in the Mudd Library. In most cases, an additional copy is held in an Annex Library or in the branch library indicated in the catalog record.

Shelving Information

Books in Library of Congress classifications are shelved in whole number order before the first decimal point, then in decimal order after the first decimal point. For example: HC79.E5G66; HC79.E5G7; HC103.S52; HC103.S6; HC103.S63. A lowercase “x” after the decimal point has no significance.

Oversize volumes are designated by a “q”, “f”, or “e” placed after the call number: AP20.R2425q; BT266.G4f; RB96.T16e. These books are usually shelved after all the non-oversize books on the same general subject. Pink stack markers indicate shelving for oversize books. **Undersize volumes** are designated by an “s” after the call number and are stored in an Annex Library.

To request a book from an Annex Library. . .

Submit a request via the Main Catalog “Request” page or the Library home page, or leave a green “Annex Library book request” slip at any Circulation Desk. Items requested will ordinarily be available within two working days.

■ Shelving Information

Books in Richardson classifications are shelved in decimal rather than whole number order. Hence, books with five or six digits before the decimal point are shelved with those having four digits before the decimal point: 1482.988; 14821.116.88; 1483.319.27; 148311.686; 1484.145; 1484.89.

Oversize volumes are designated by a “q”, “f”, or “e” placed after the call number: 0901.N594q; 3170.33.398f; 1821.358.11e. These books are usually shelved after all the non-oversize books on the same general subject. Pink stack markers indicate shelving for oversize books. **Undersize volumes** are designated by an “s” following the call number and are shelved in an Annex Library.

■ To request a book from an Annex Library. . .

Submit a request via the Main Catalog “Request” page or the Library home page, or leave a green “Annex Library book request” slip at any Circulation Desk. Items requested from an Annex will ordinarily be available within two working days.

■ Call Numbers for Materials in Microformat

Records in the Main Catalog for materials in microformat (microfiche, microfilm, microcard, and microprint) always provide a location designation, e.g. (Film), (GestF), (SVF). Records for microfilms in the Supplementary Catalog ordinarily provide a location designation. Records in the Supplementary Catalog for microfiche, microprints, and microcards provide location designations *unless* the location is (Film), which may be assumed if it is not indicated. For further assistance, please consult a librarian or inquire at the Microforms Service, C-7-E Firestone Library.

■ Pitney Collection on International Law and Diplomacy

Books in the (PITN) location, classified in JX and JZ, are shelved after the J – JV oversized books, beginning at B-13-F. The special classification PITN 001 – PITN 973, used primarily for older books and journals in the Pitney Collection, begins thereafter, at B-12-F.
